





The Legacy Wall is a one-of-a-kind traveling exhibit that features 125 "mini-biographies" of LGBT people from every walk of life. This powerful, positive, and inspiring exhibit is 24' long by 8' tall by 6' deep. Its 300 square-feet of digitally interactive content is international and multicultural, spans 4000 years of history, and has been substantially vetted and sourced. It has been thoughtfully designed to enlighten people about the many important roles LGBT people have played in shared human history – information which helps to boost the self-esteem of LGBTQ youth who are forced to grow up without the benefit of historically significant role-models. Learning about these accomplishments has been shown to dramatically lessen incidences of bullying by encouraging a culture of respect and an appreciation for diversity. The Legacy Wall uses the lessons of history to spark conversations and promote a feeling of safety and belonging in the classroom – giving our children hope by improving their outlook on life.
